President's Report:

- Third car parking permits do not have guaranteed spaces.
- There has been some improvement to the oil near garage 62. There is still oil around the garage door. The board will continue to monitor the area.
- There are some gutters overflowing due to heavy rains and leaves in the gutters. Some areas may gather water and create puddles. The board will reach out to "our gutter guy" late November, early December when the leaves have all fallen.

Old Business:

- Transblue requested additional funds for the chimney stack project. They have subcontracted the project. The board has approved this adjustment in cost. Work will proceed as weather allows.
- Work is going smoothly with the sidewalk repairs. Work will happen as weather allows.
- Dryer vent work has completed, and Chimney inspections should commence 11/12.

New Business:

- Unit 43 mention some sidewalks could use some pressure washing. The board is planning on having this be a spring project when the irrigation system is no longer winterized.
- Units 47-50 and 75-78 had usually high water bills for the month. The board will monitor the water meters for these buildings and make sure that our numbers match what the water company is billing.
